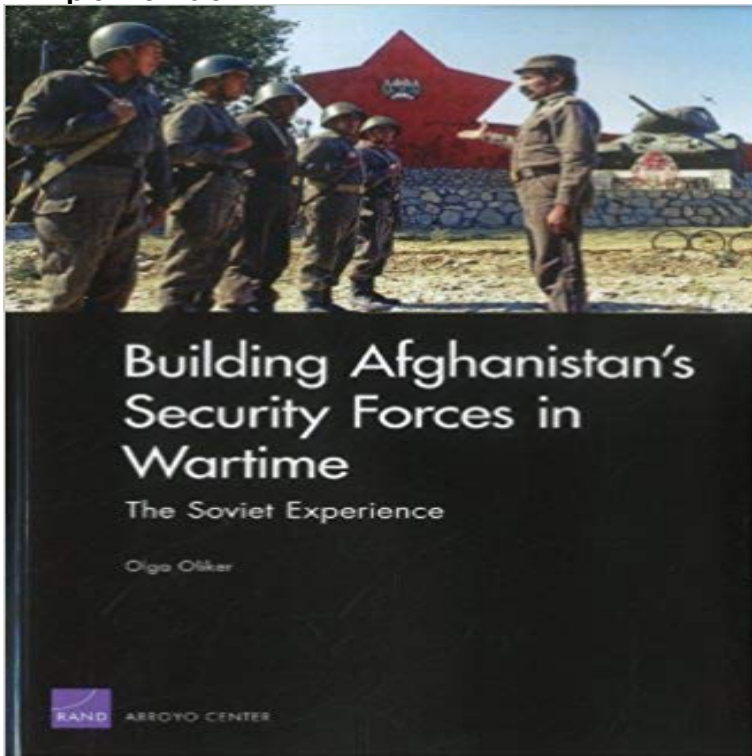


Building Afghanistan's Security Forces in Wartime: The Soviet Experience
