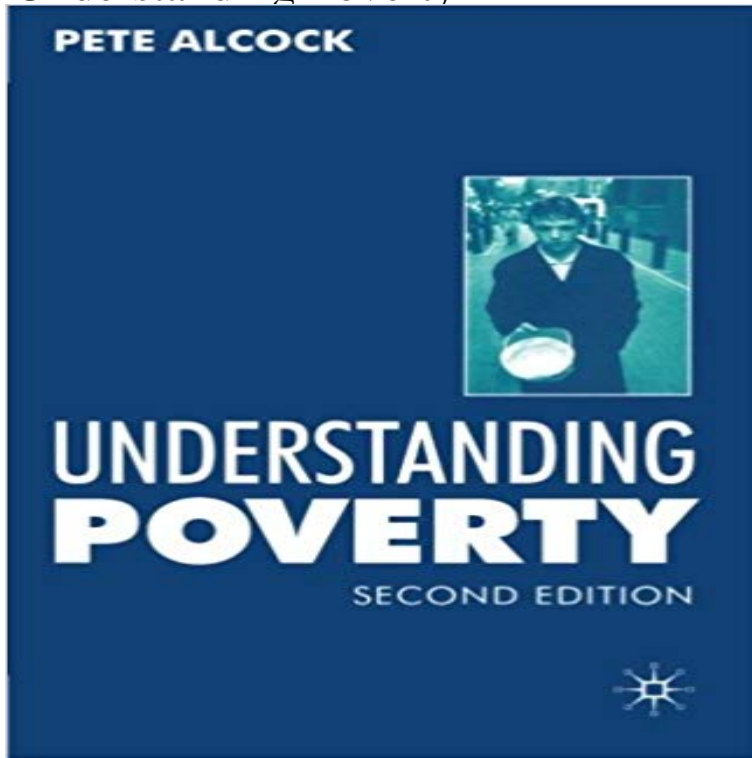


Understanding Poverty
