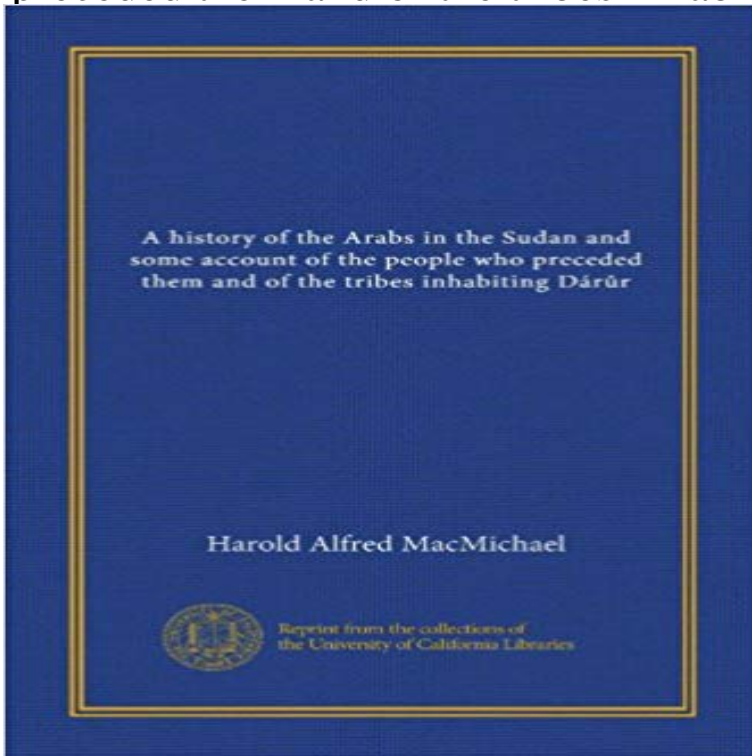


A history of the Arabs in the Sudan and some account of the people who preceded them and of the tribes inhabiting Darur (v.2)
