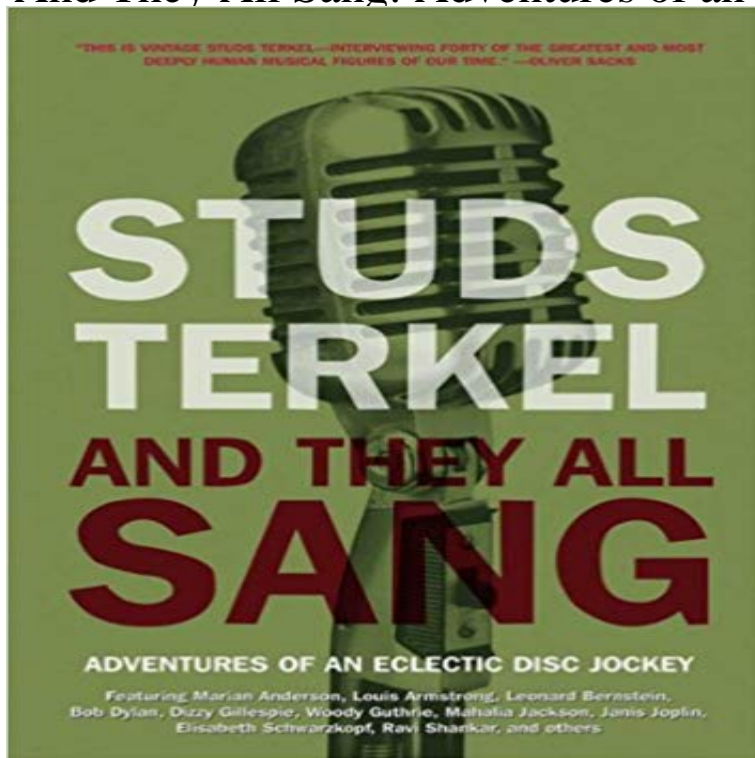


And They All Sang: Adventures of an Eclectic Disc Jockey
