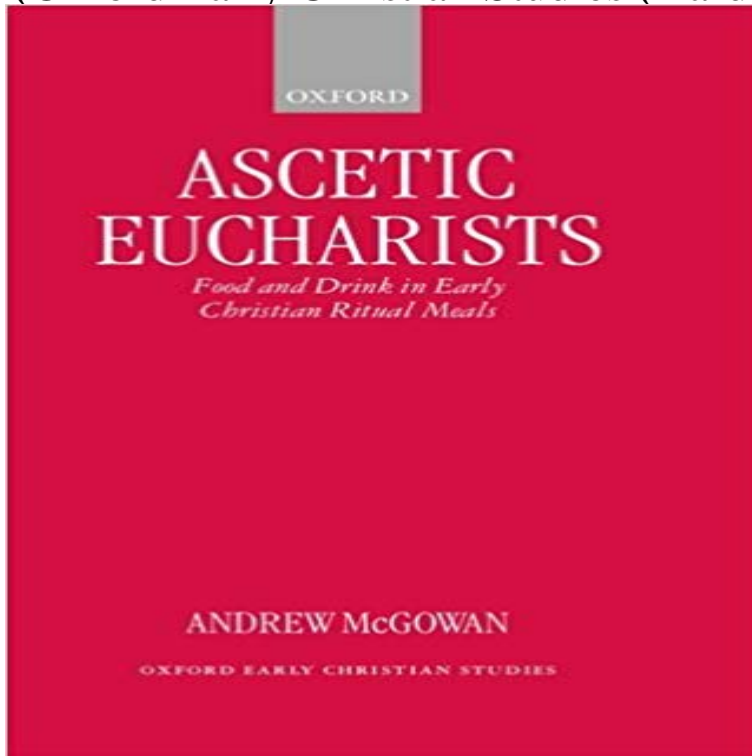


Ascetic Eucharists: Food and Drink in Early Christian Ritual Meals (Oxford Early Christian Studies (Hardcover))

In fact, the evidence suggests great diversity in conduct, including the use of foods, in the first few hundred years.
