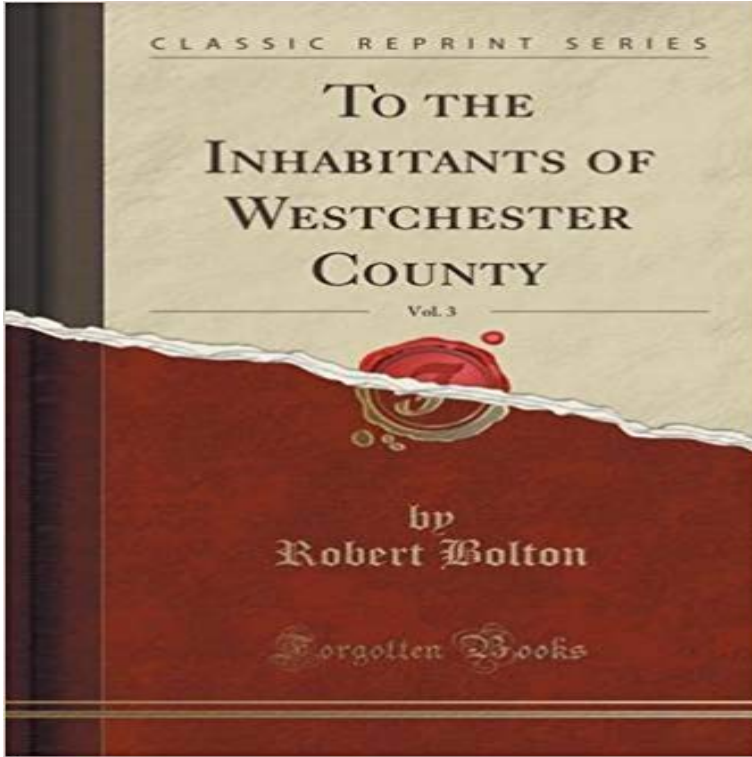

The beauty of its scenery, and the interesting circumstances connected with its history, both civil and military, entitle it to peculiar notice. A history of the county is certainly a desideratum. Whether this deficiency will be supplied by the present volumes, the author leaves to be decided by more competent judges than himself. In review of his labors he would state that nearly four years of patient research have been expended upon the completion of his undertaking. He is well aware that he cannot expect to please all classes of readers alike, especially as affairs which may appear inconsiderable to one, will be replete with interest to another. He has endeavored to abridge and condense his materials, in order not to trespass upon the patience of the general reader; while he has been equally careful upon the other hand not to omit any details which might prove interesting and important to individuals or local authorities. The transitions of property and the history of families are therefore brought prominently forward; and nothing, it is hoped, has been introduced which can be considered altogether superfluous. For the present, the author would commit the compilation to the public, trusting that the generous reader will make all due allowance for a work of such varied matter.
