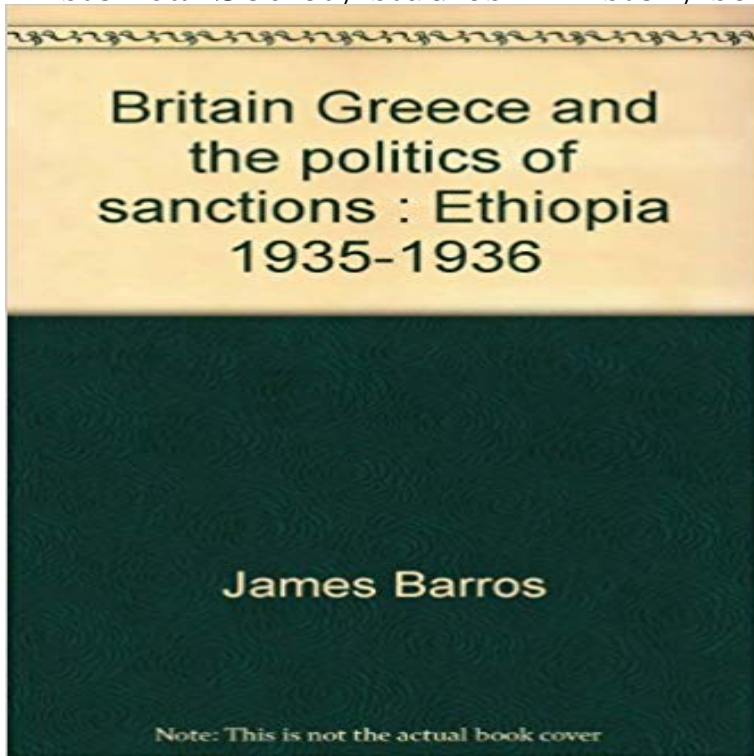


# Britain, Greece, and the politics of sanctions: Ethiopia, 1935-1936 (Royal Historical Society studies in history series)
