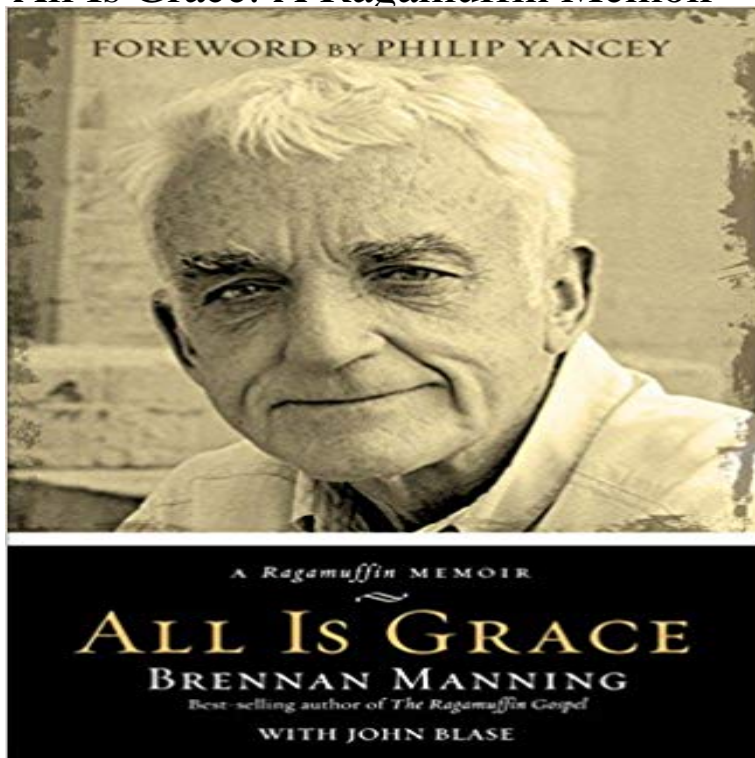


# All Is Grace: A Ragamuffin Memoir
