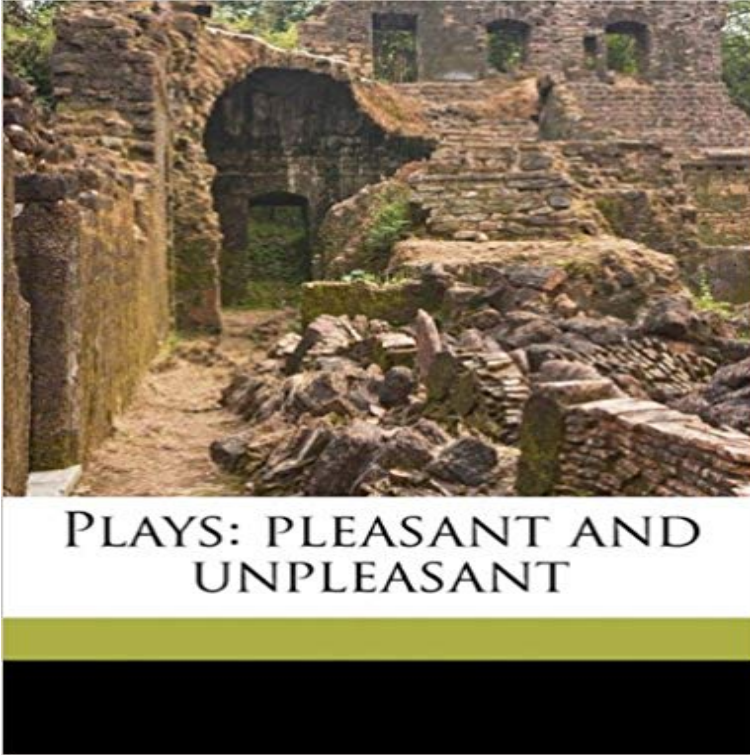


Plays: pleasant and unpleasant
