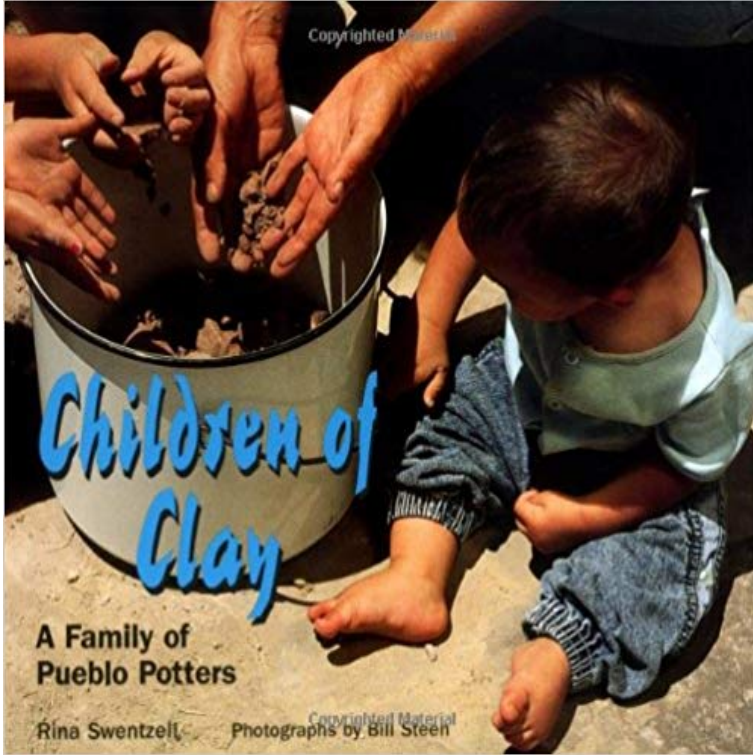


Children of Clay: A Family of Pueblo Potters (We Are Still Here)
