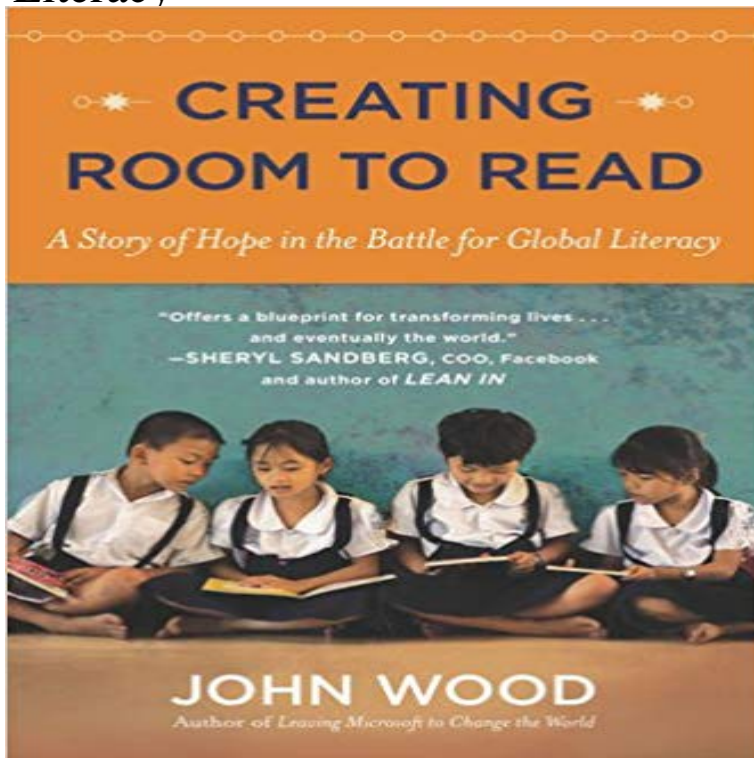


Creating Room to Read: A Story of Hope in the Battle for Global Literacy
