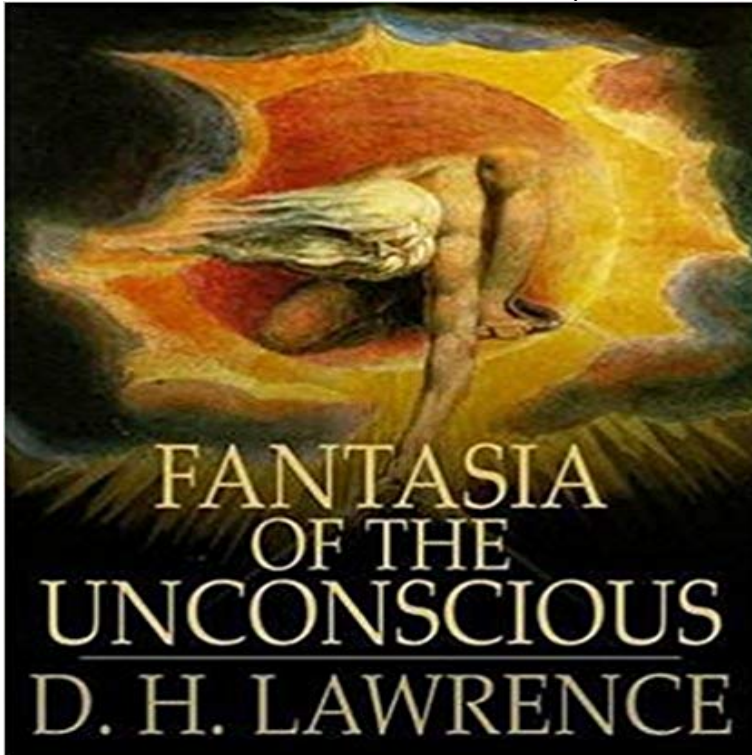


Fantasia of the Unconscious (Illustrated)
