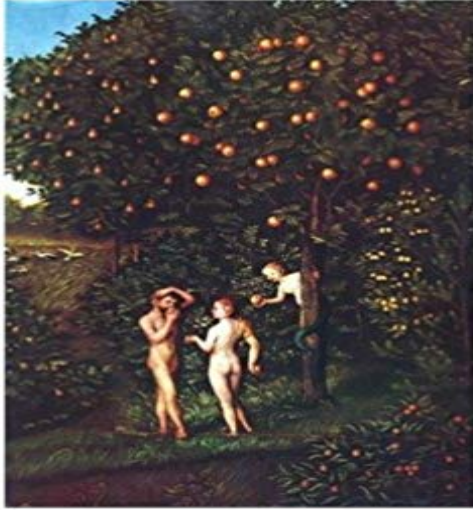

This isn't to say that these documents are forgeries, just that for one reason or another they were not considered part of the Biblical text by the first millennium (C.E.) compilers. This book contains translations of the text found in volume I of the weighty Oxford University Press Apocrypha and Pseudepigrapha. It fills in for a lot of missing information.
