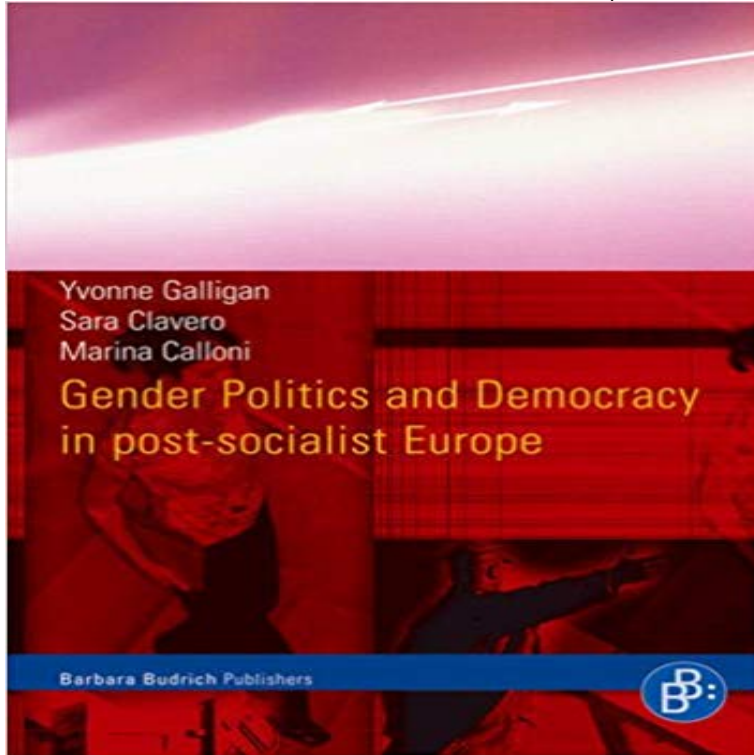


Gender Politics and Democracy in Post-Socialist Europe
