

High blood sugar during pregnancy can result in gestational diabetes, which can put the baby Before the gestational diabetes test, pregnant women should fast overnight for at least eight hours. The next morning, doctors will check fasting blood glucose, then give an oral glucose tolerance test (OGTT).
