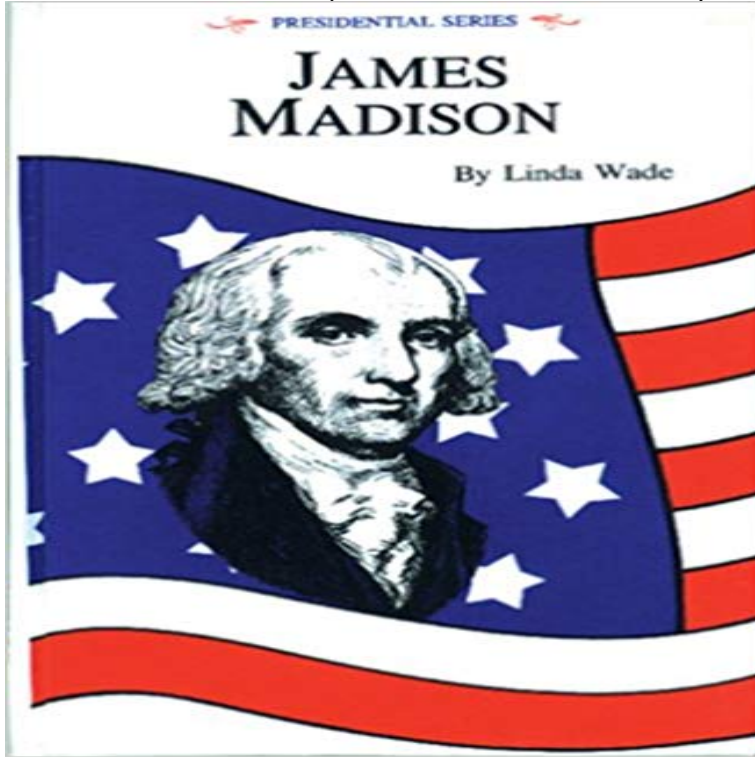


James Madison (Presidential Series)
