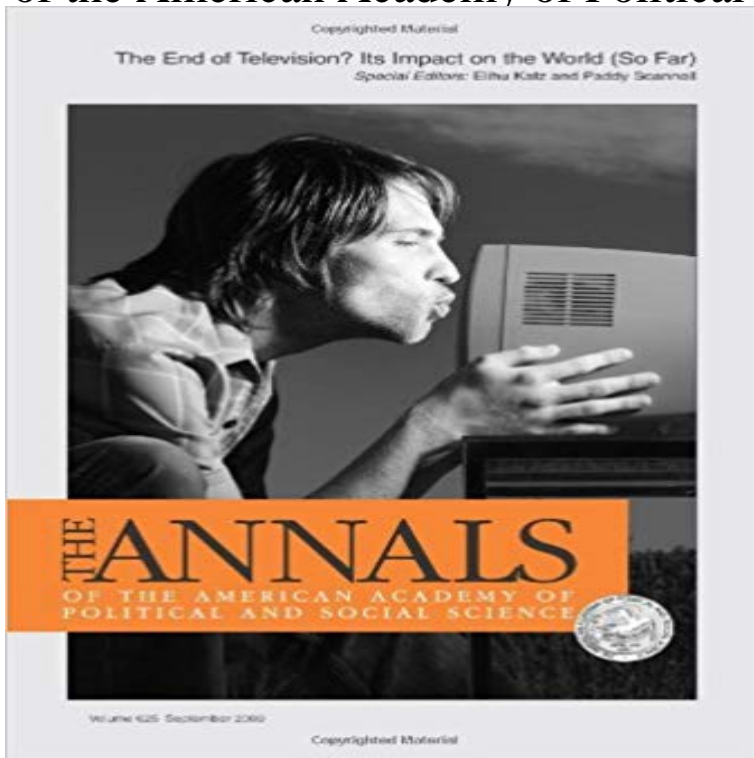


The End of Television?: Its Impact on the World (So Far) (The ANNALS of the American Academy of Political and Social Science Series)
