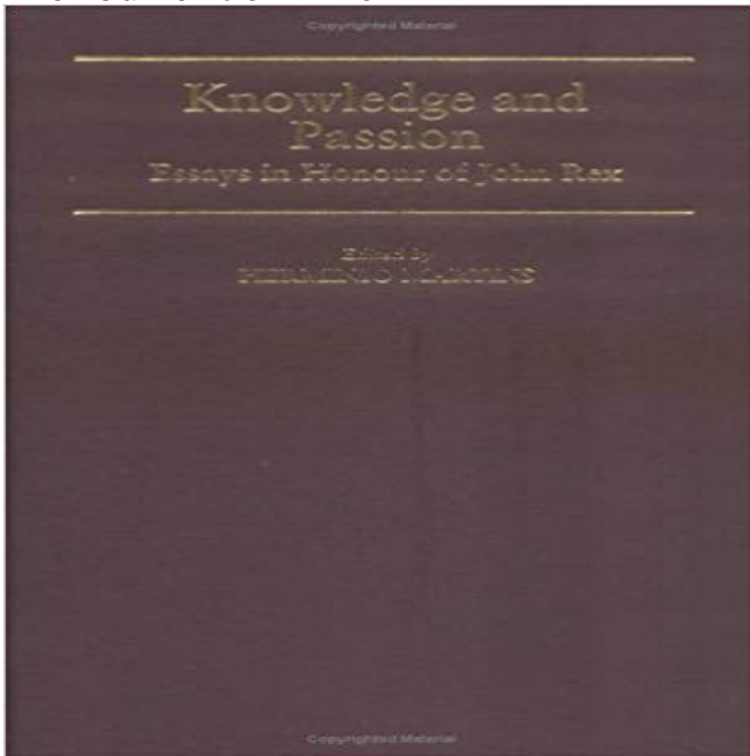


# Knowledge and Passion: Essays in Sociology and Social Theory in Honour of John Rex
