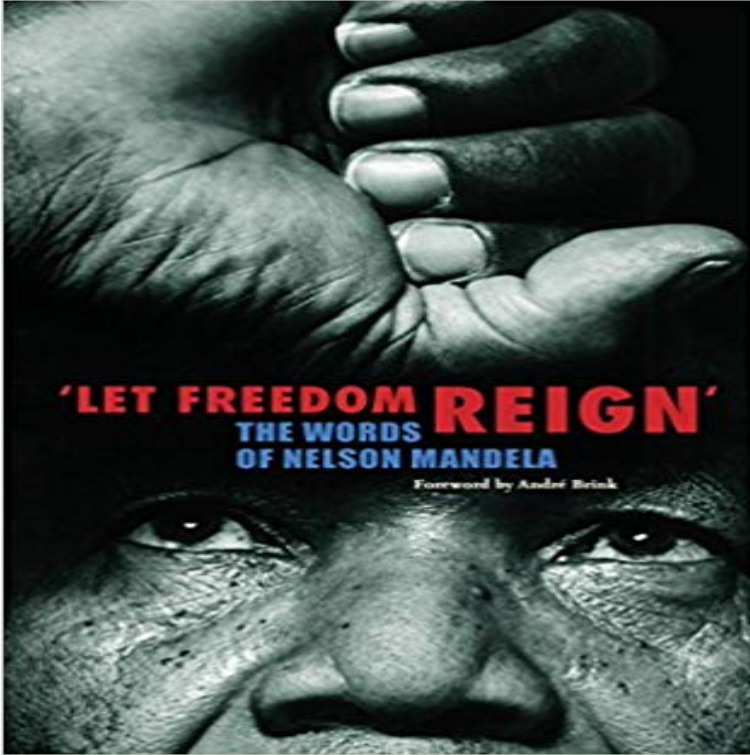


Let Freedom Reign: The Words of Nelson Mandela
