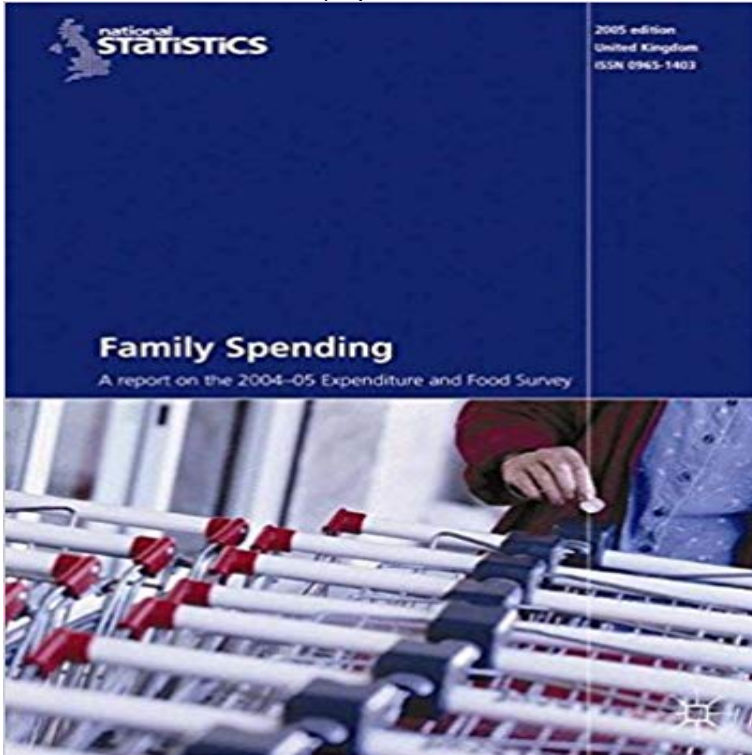


Family Spending (2004-2005): A Report on the 2004-2005 Expenditure and Food Survey (Office of National Statistics)



Family Spending provides analysis of household expenditure broken down by age and income, household composition, socio-economic characteristics and geography. These figures are based on information collected in the period April 2004 to March 2005 from the Expenditure and Food Survey based on around 7,000 households in the UK.
