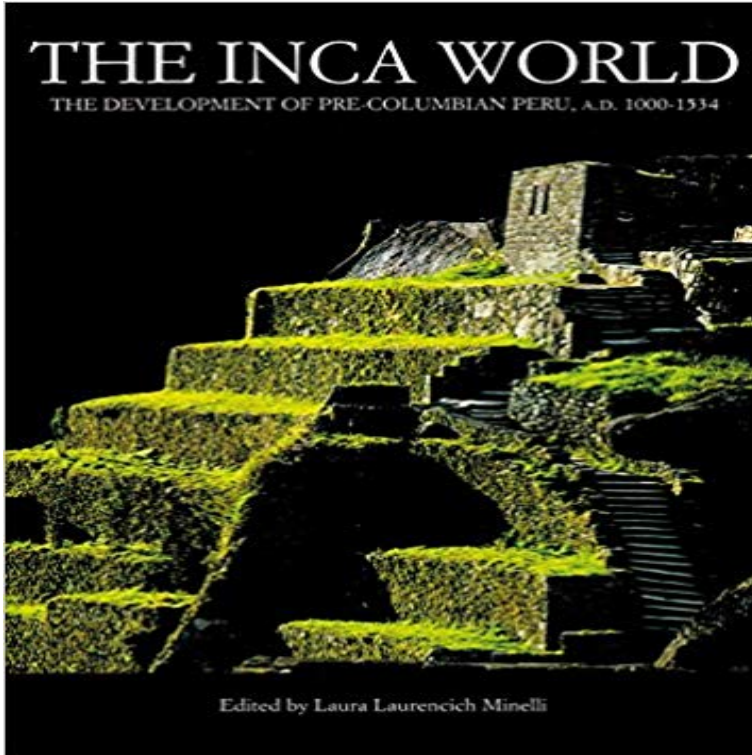


The Inca World
