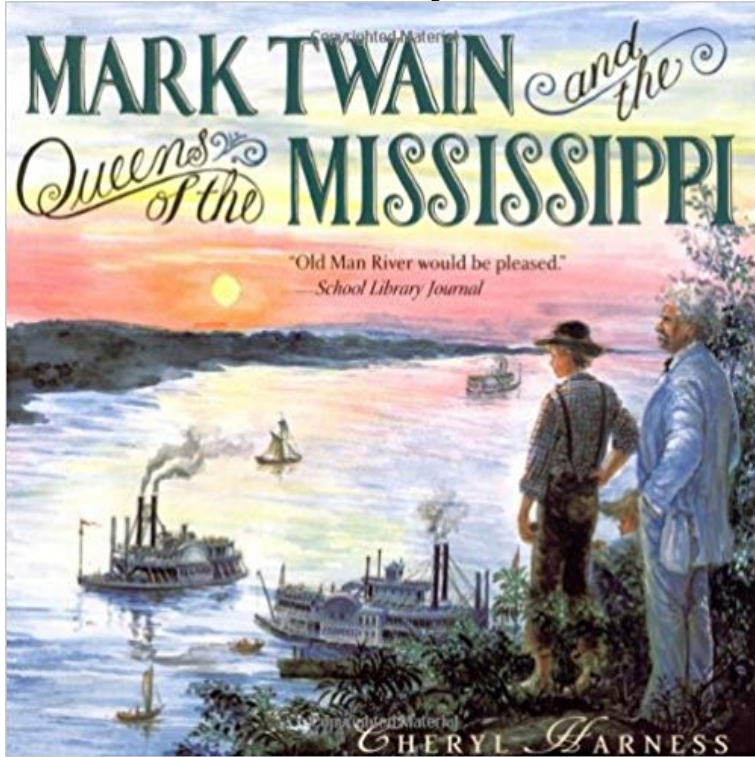


# Mark Twain and the Queens of the Mississippi
