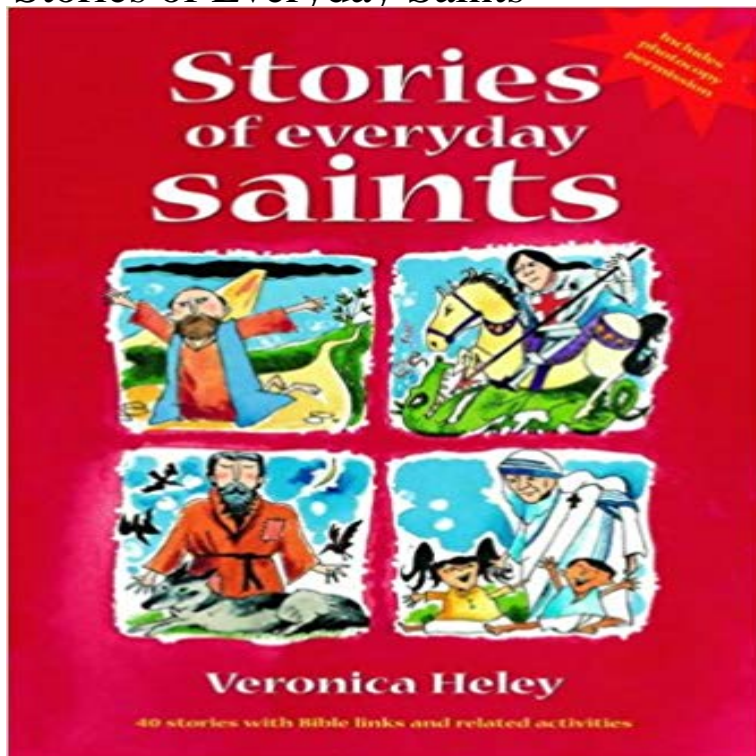


Stories of Everyday Saints
