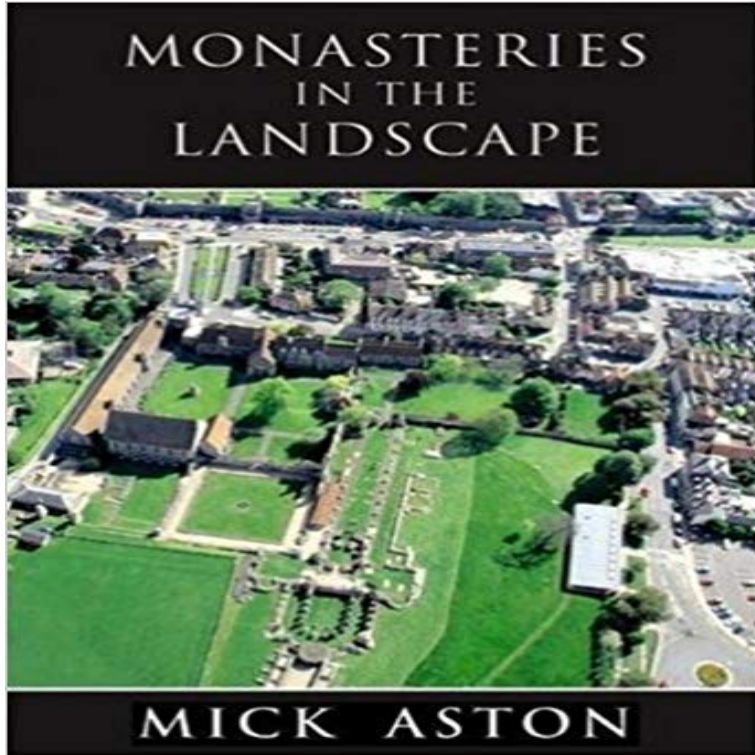


MONASTERIES IN THE LANDSCAPE
