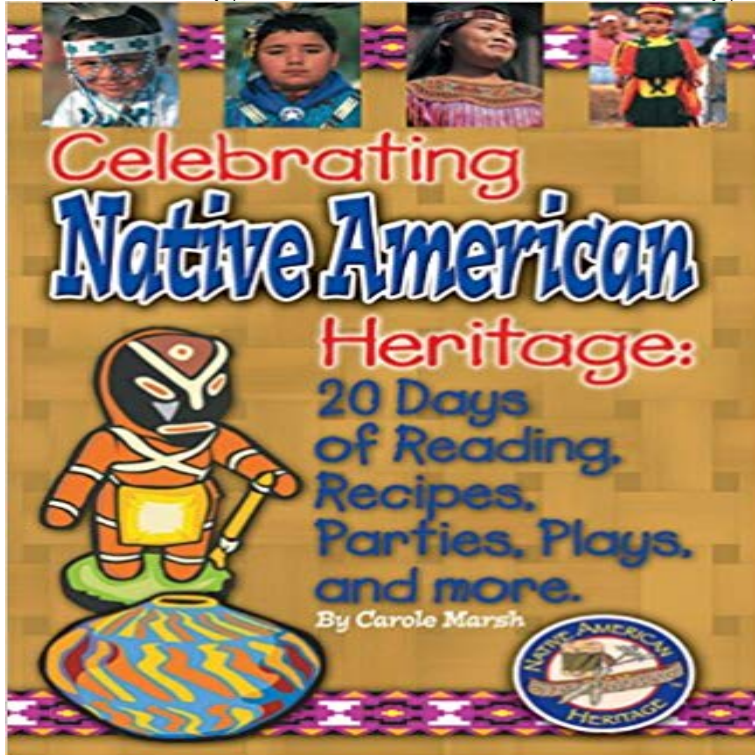


Celebrating Native American Heritage
