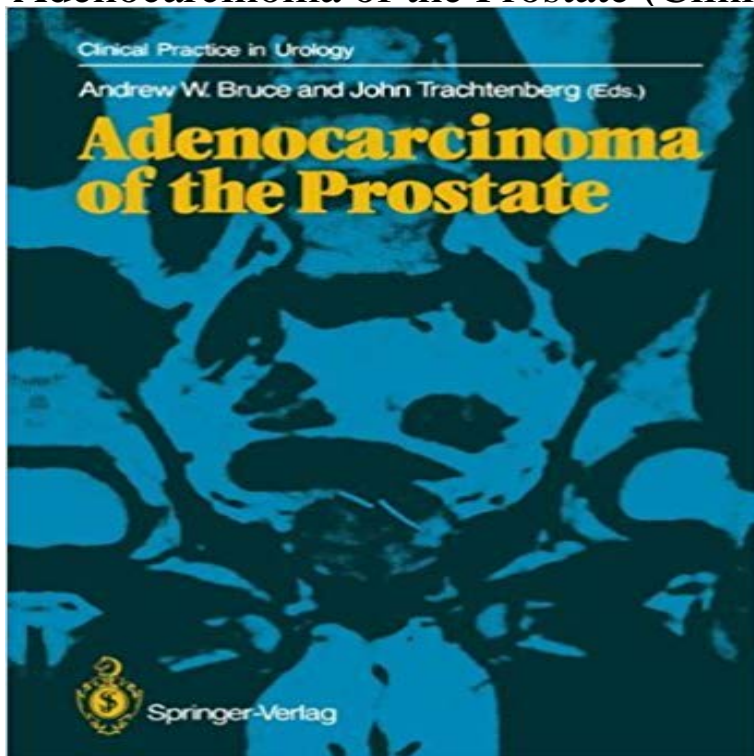


Adenocarcinoma of the Prostate (Clinical Practice in Urology)
