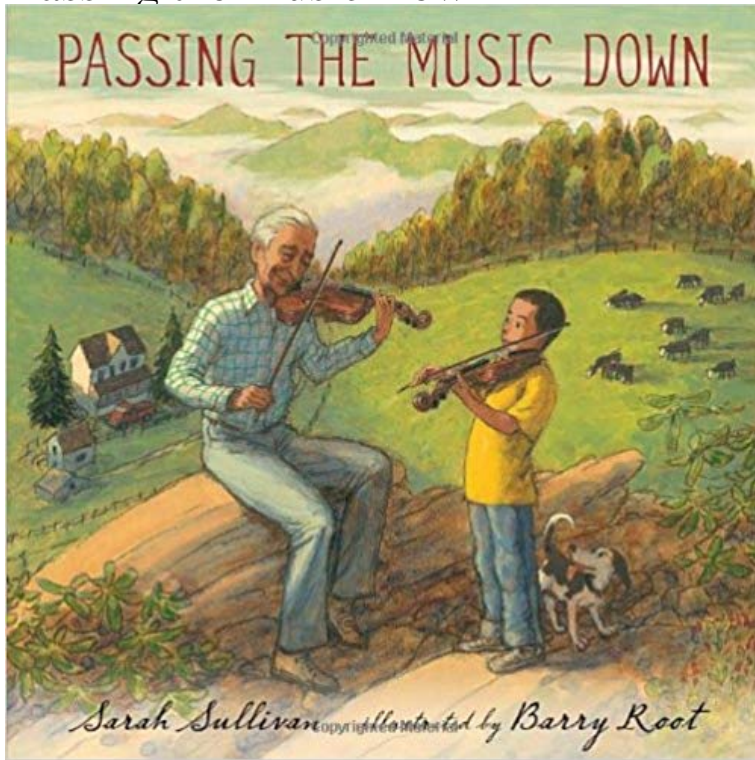


## Passing the Music Down
