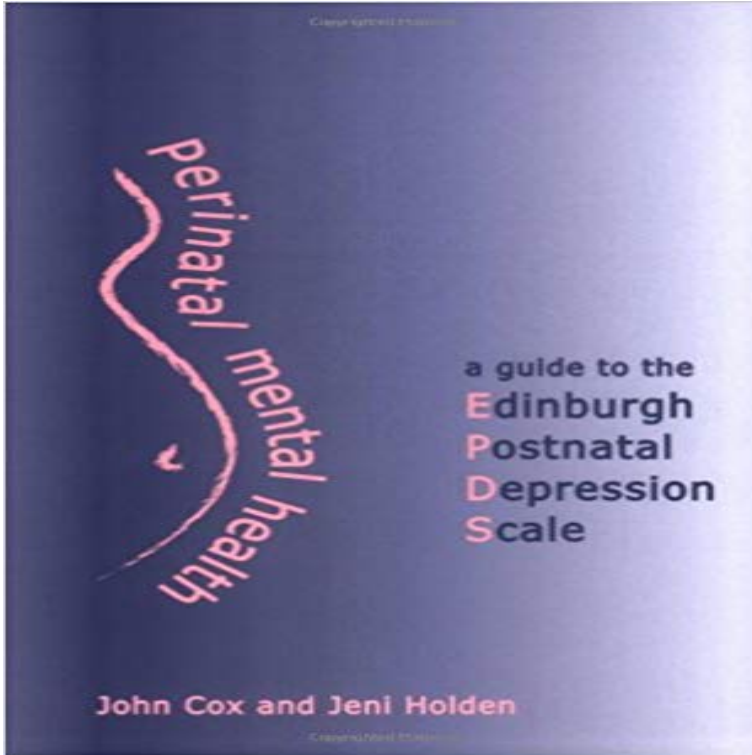


Perinatal Mental Health: A Guide to the EPDS
