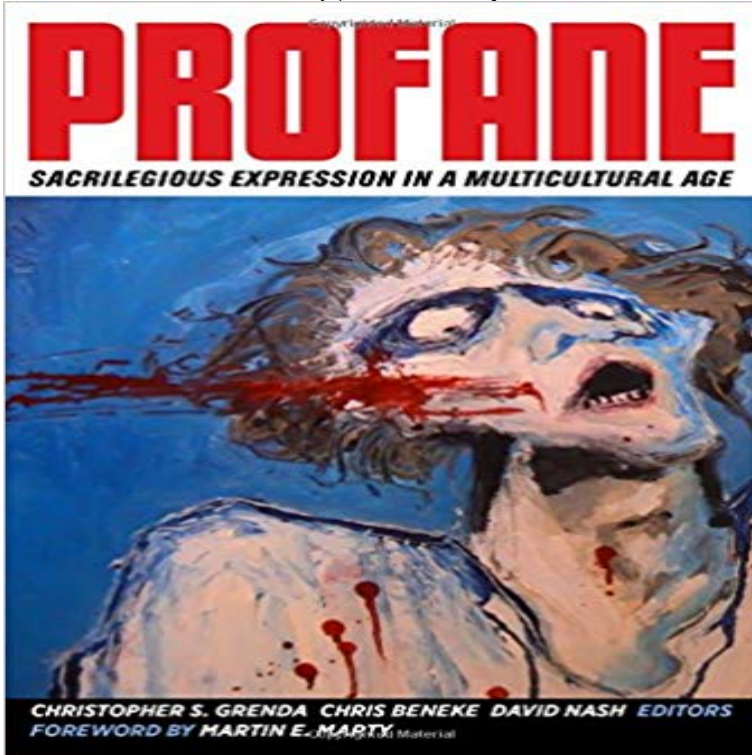


# Profane: Sacrilegious Expression in a Multicultural Age
