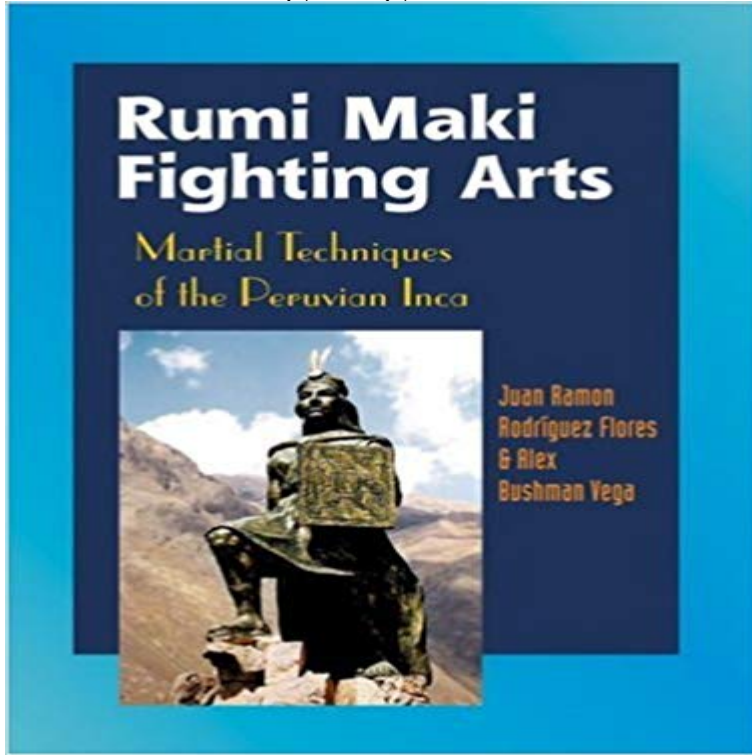


Rumi Maki Fighting Arts: Martial Techniques of the Peruvian Inca
