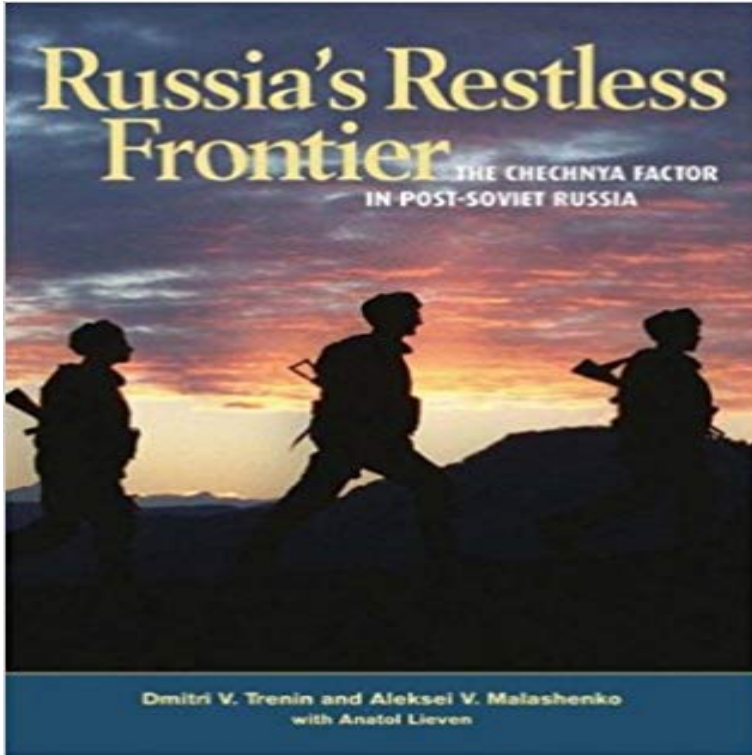


# Russia's Restless Frontier: The Chechnya Factor in Post-Soviet Russia
