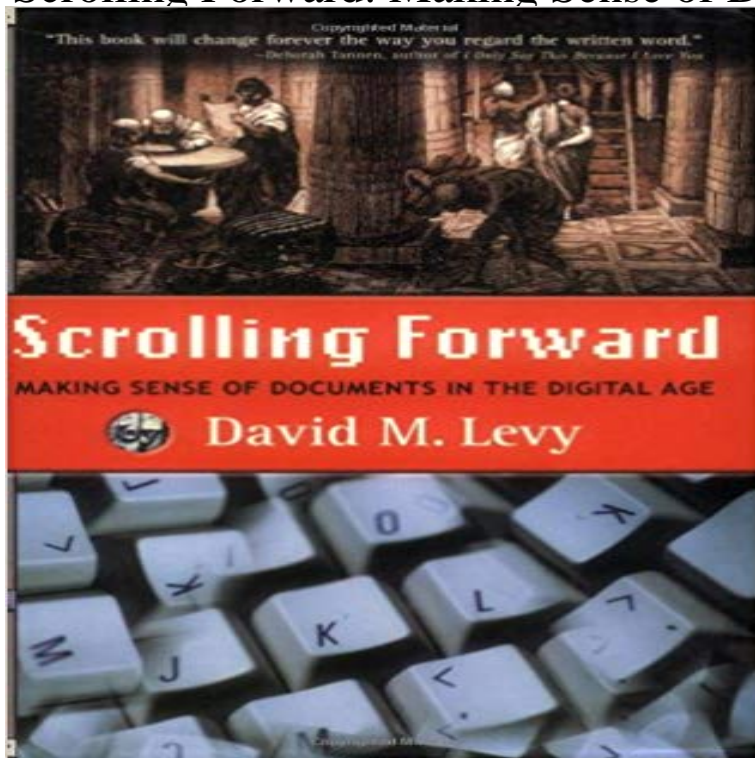


Scrolling Forward: Making Sense of Documents in the Digital Age
