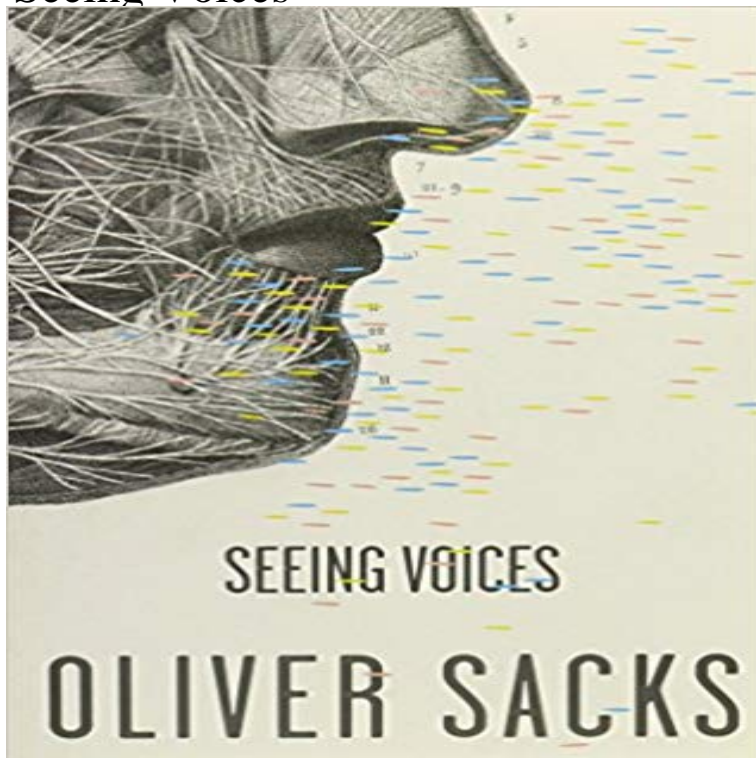


Seeing Voices
