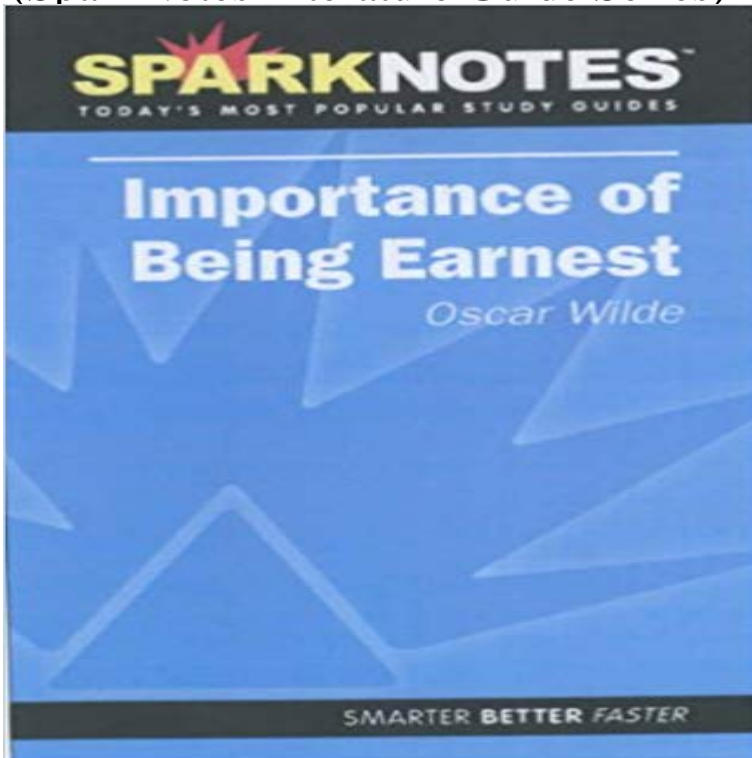


# The Importance of Being Earnest (SparkNotes Literature Guide Series)
