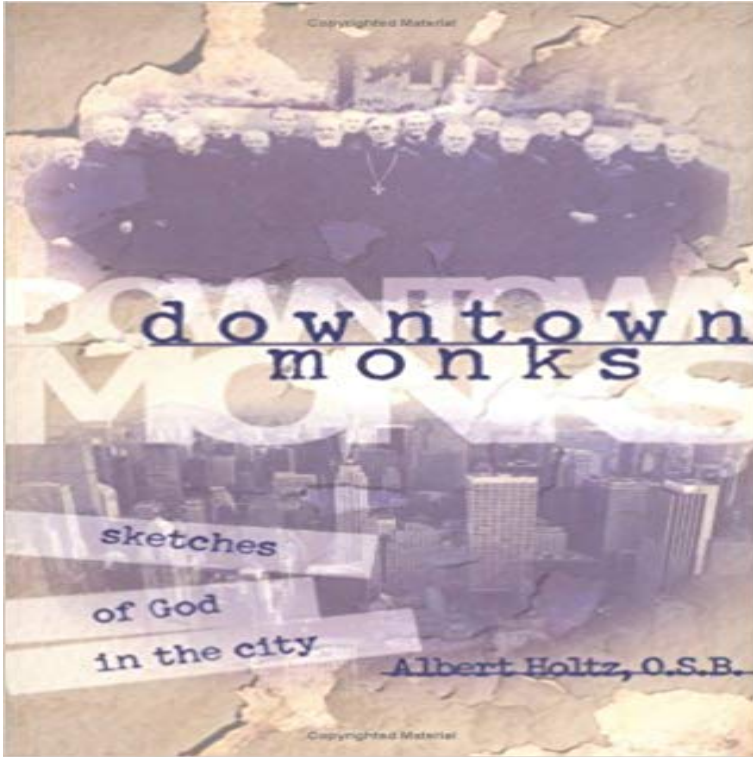


Downtown Monks: Sketches of God in the City
