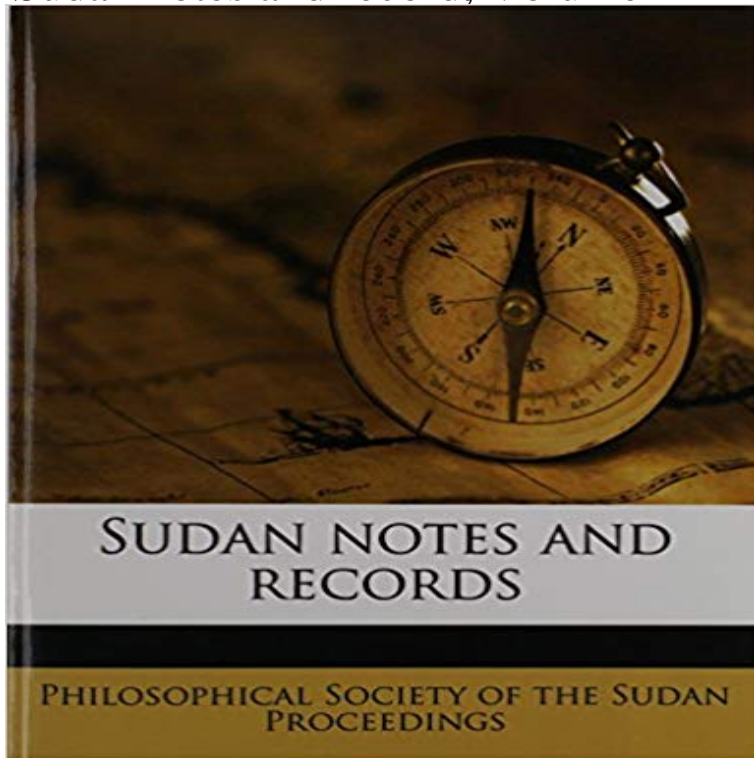


Sudan notes and record, Volume 1
