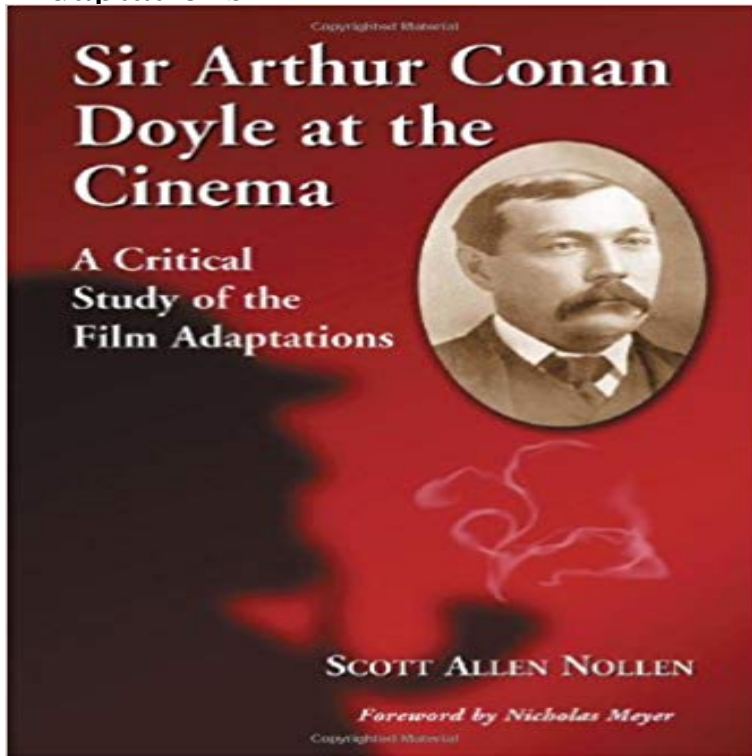


Sir Arthur Conan Doyle at the Cinema: A Critical Study of the Film Adaptations
