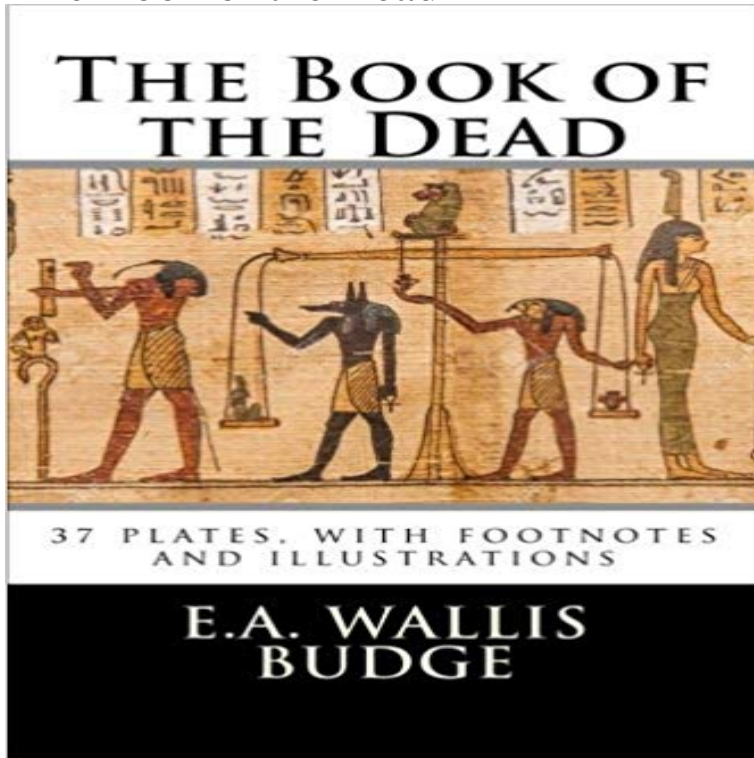


The Book of the Dead
