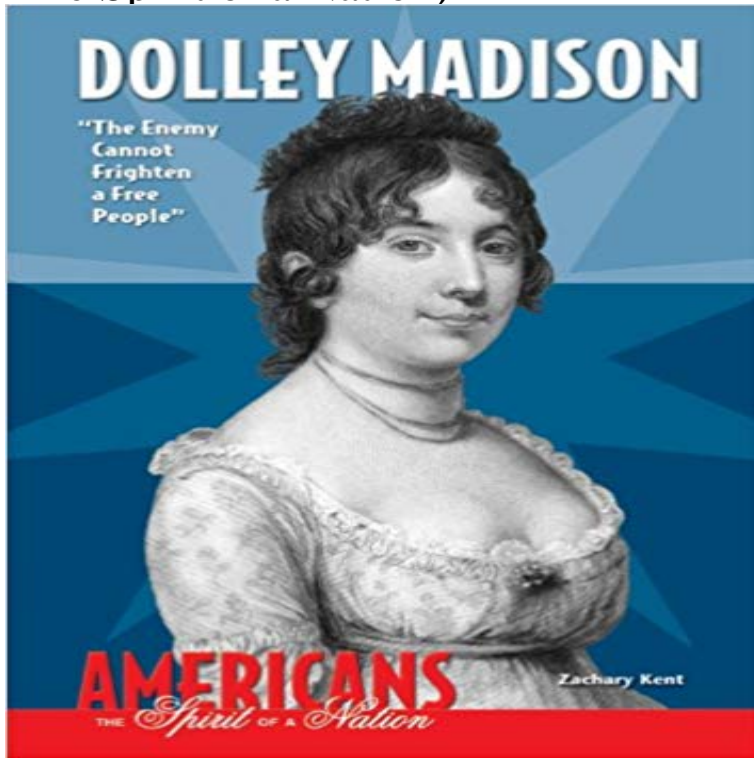


# Dolley Madison: The Enemy Cannot Frighten a Free People (Americans: The Spirit of a Nation)
