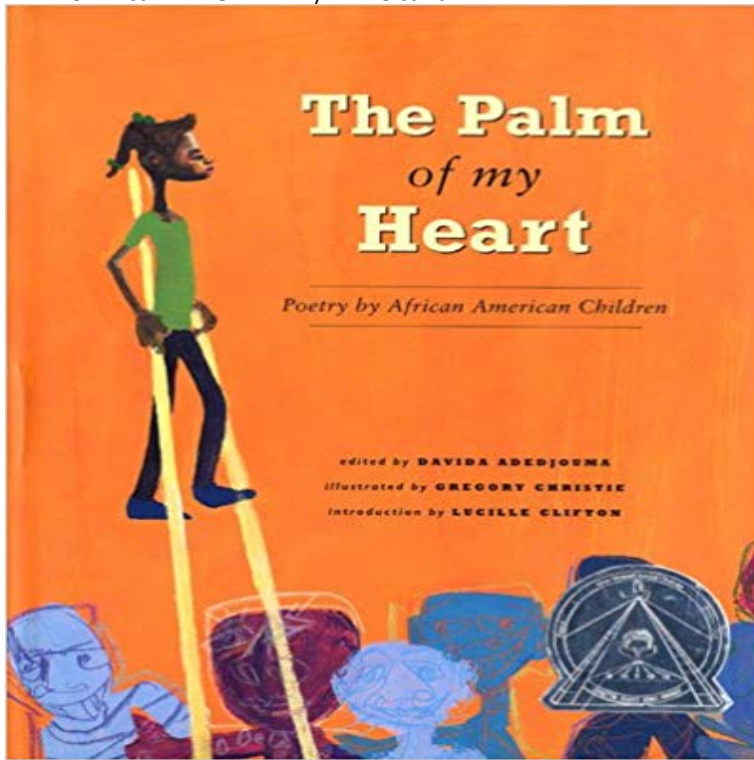


The Palm of My Heart
