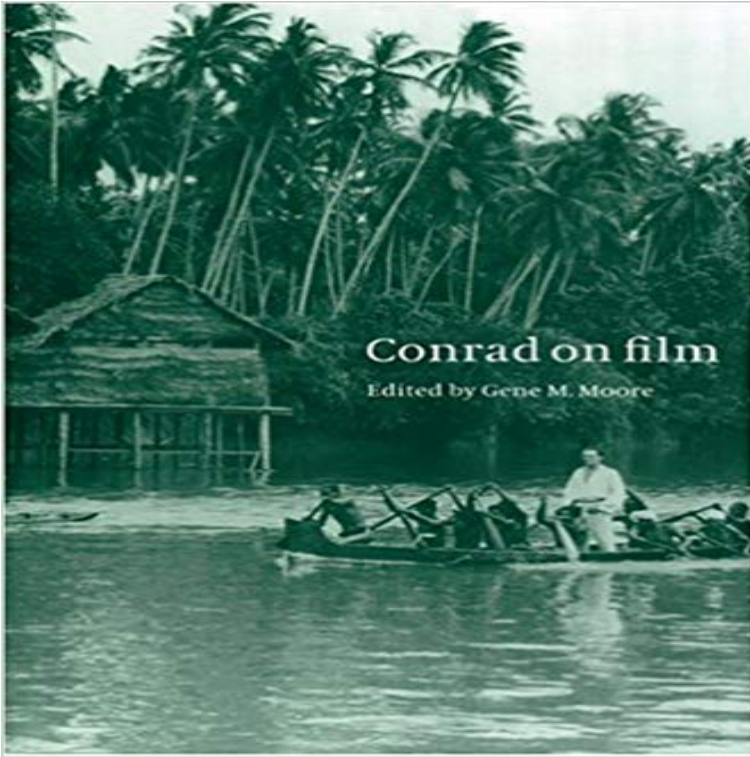


Conrad on Film
