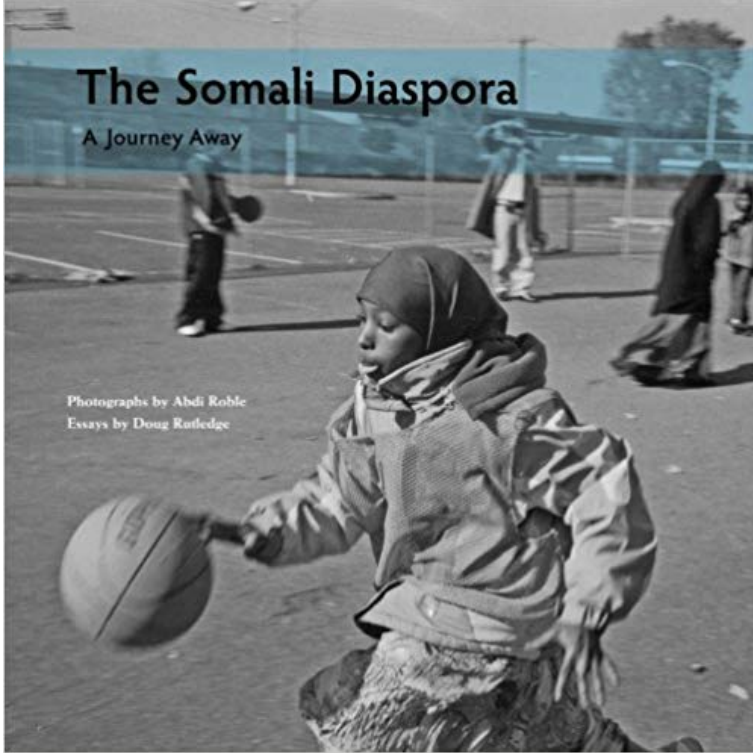


# The Somali Diaspora: A Journey Away
