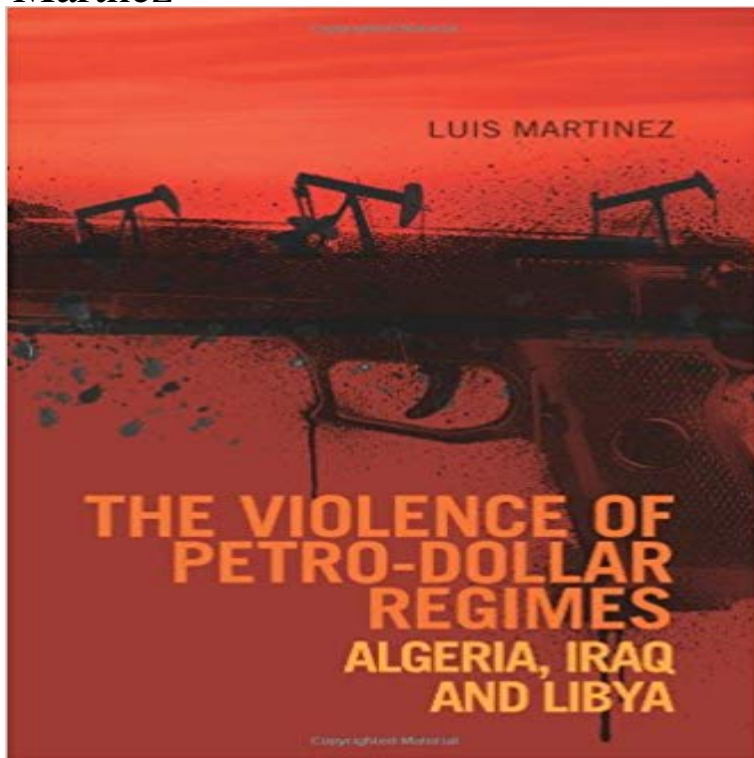


The Violence of Petro-Dollar Regimes: Algeria, Iraq and Libya. Luis Martnez
