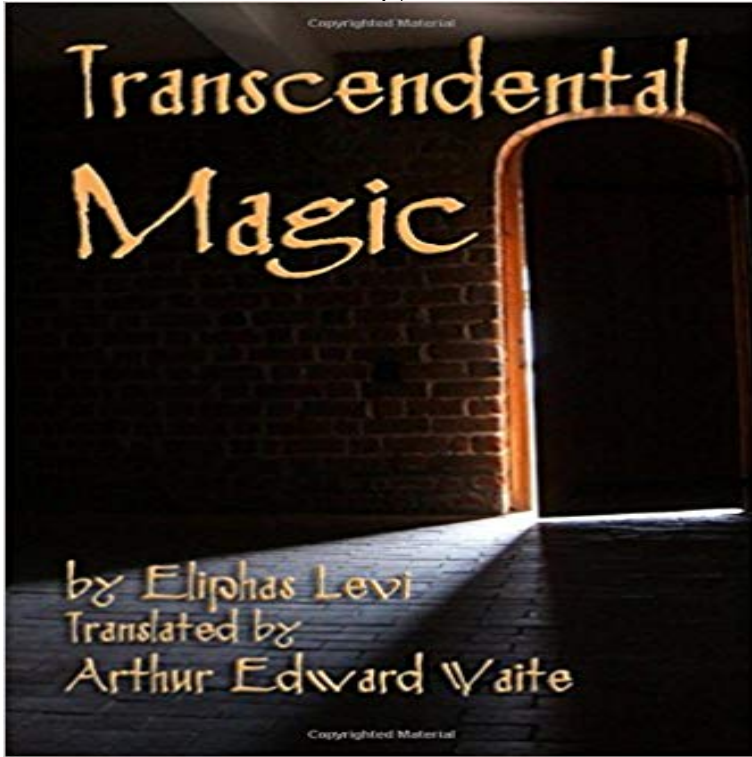


Transcendental Magic
