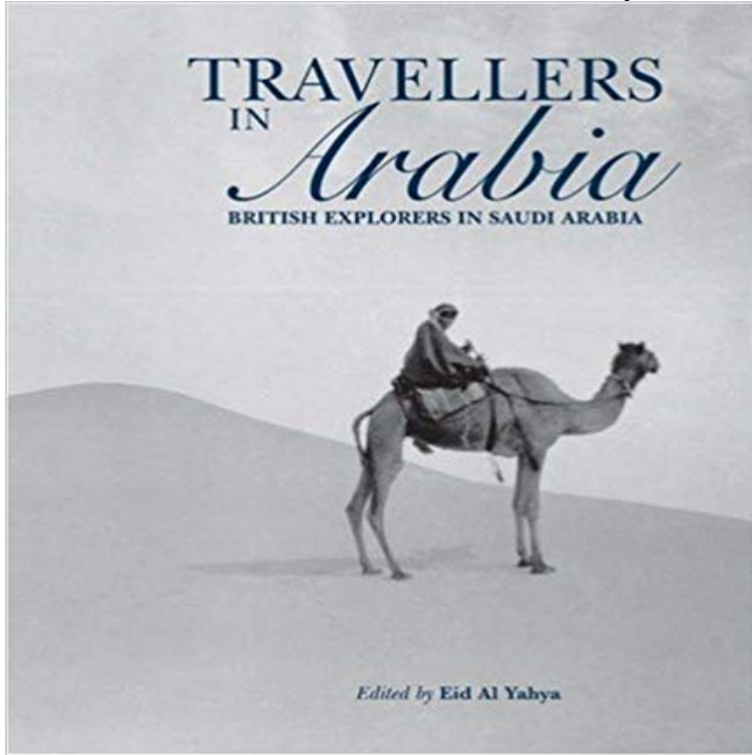


Travellers in Arabia: British Explorers in Saudi Arabia
